Department of Homeland Security Regulations Affect on Agriculture

- What:** The Nisei Farmers League and Fresno County Farm Bureau, in conjunction with other valley agricultural organizations, growers and Farm Labor Contractors, will host a press conference to discuss the agricultural response to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security regulations dealing with illegal immigration and hiring practices of employers.
